MTX-15 Ethernet Terminal Connection with Time Guardian (TG) v5.0 procedure

- 1. Set the ip, using the dgdscvr utility ping test
- 2. Then on time guardian, go to Edit > setup
- 3. Clock > yes, yes, no, yes
- 4. Click on location terminal
- 5. Click garbage if says fpt
- 6. Go to connection tab, ethernet
- 7. Enter the ip
- 8. Verify port 2101
- 9. Next tab, terminal
- 10. Press the magnifying glass
- 11. Once serial shows, double click
- 12. Change validation to default
- 13. Verify active is checked
- 14. Click green check mark
- 15. Press green check again
- 16. Press green check again
- 17. Go to communications
- 18. Highlight mtx
- 19. 4 green buttons on bottom right
- 20. Press 2nd from left, this will set time to test communication

Note: If this procedure fails, tcp port 2101 may be blocked by the firewall
